

Scholarships

Students may please be informed that they are eligible for scholarship from respective state governments / central governments as detailed below:

For Kerala students: e-grantz scholarship

Students belongs to SC/ST/OEC/OBC(H) are eligible for getting scholarship from Government of Kerala.

How to register in the portal ?

After taking admission in the Institute students are required to do the online registration in "www.e-grantz3.0" portal by uploading the following documents. After the online registration they will get a printout, with that printout and copies of the uploaded documents they should submit the same to the college for verification.

Documents required for registration

1. Aadhaar Card
2. Original Caste Certificate(from date of issue 3 year validity)
3. Original Income Certificate (from date of issue 1 year validity)
4. Students Bank pass book front page
5. Allotment memo
6. Hostel inmate certificate (for hostel staying students)
7. Qualification documents (10th & +2)

Fisheries e-grantz scholarship

7. Qualification documents (10th & +2)

1. Post Matric Scholarships Scheme for Minorities
2. Top Class Education Scheme for SC Students- 2 students
3. National Fellowship and Scholarship for Higher Education of ST Students - Scholarship (Formally Top Class Education for Schedule Tribe Students) - only for scholarships.
4. CENTRAL SECTOR SCHEME OF SCHOLARSHIPS FOR COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY STUDENTS
5. Prime Minister's Scholarship Scheme For Central Armed Police Forces And Assam Rifles

Registration Process for Fresh Students:

a) Students applying for scholarship for the first time need to "Register" on the portal as fresh applicant, using the icon "New Registration" at NSP Portal URL - <https://scholarships.gov.in/>, by providing accurate and correct information as per their documents.

b) Before initiating registration process, students are advised to carefully go through the "Guidelines for Registration on National Scholarship Portal" and keep their Educational and other documents such as Aadhaar number, Enrolment number, Bank passbook etc. in hand.

STEP 1: REGISTRATION AT <https://scholarships.gov.in/>

STEP 2: SUBMITTING APPLICATION BY UPLOADING REQUIRED DOCUMENTS GIVEN IN THE "GUIDELINES".

STEP 3: TAKE A PRINT OUT OF THE APPLICATION.

STEP 4: SUBMIT THE DULY SIGNED APPLICATION WITH THE COPIES OF THE UPLOADED DOCUMENTS TO THE INSTITUTE FOR THE VERIFICATION AT INSTITUTE LEVEL.

NB: After submitting the application, the students should submit the duly signed print out of the application with copy of the uploaded documents for the verification at institute level.
