

**HOSTEL SPECIAL RULES FOR ONE AND HALF YEAR DIPLOMA IN
FOOD PRODUCTION STUDENTS**

1. Hostel stay is optional for the Student.
2. Those who have opted for hostel (irrespective of state) are required to bring **Covid-19 Negative Certificate (RT-PCR)** obtained within 72 hours prior to the date of entry to the institute.
3. Students will be provided with
 - Cot
 - Table
 - Chair
 - One cupboard.

All other personal requirements has to be brought by the students. Hostel accommodation will be provided from 7th April 2021 onwards till 11nd of May 2021 (1 month)

4. Allotment of hostel rooms shall be done for students only under need-based circumstances.
5. Students residing in the hostels have to pay the monthly hostel fees of Rs. 6,600, which includes Boarding and Lodging as per the Institute norms. Food deliveries by Zomato/Swiggy etc. will not be allowed.
6. Students will not be allowed to roam inside the campus (e.g. Academic area, Library, Computer Lab, etc.) without justified reasons.
7. Day scholars will not be allowed to leave campus before the end of the day's classes.
8. Hostelites cannot leave the campus during the stay in the hostel. Hostelites are to be confined in their rooms during the free hours.
9. Students residing in the hostels will not be allowed to go to their homes/hometowns on weekends.

10. It is mandatory for the students to install the Aarogya Setu App and to keep Bluetooth and Location app in the ON mode, at all the times.
11. The Institute reserves the right to expel any student from the Hostel if the student does not follow the above rules and other restrictions/advisories issued by Government of India / Govt. of Kerala/ institute.
12. It will be the responsibility of the student and their parents to comply to all the rules/regulation related to COVID-19 protocol.
13. Violation of the COVID 19 protocol is punishable as per the Disaster Management Act. The Institute will not be responsible for the consequences.
14. Generic Preventive measures / Covid-19 Appropriate Behaviour:
 - (i) Physical distancing of atleast 6 feet to be followed as far as feasible.
 - (ii) Use of face covers/masks to be made mandatory.
 - (iii) Frequent handwashing with soap (for atleast 40-60 seconds)even when hands are not visibly dirty. Use of alcohol-based hand sanitizers (for atleast 20 seconds) can be done wherever feasible.
 - (iv) Respiratory etiquette to be strictly followed. This involves strict practices of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue / handkerchief/ flexed elbow and disposing of used tissues properly.
 - (v) Self –monitoring of health by all and reporting any illness at the earliest.
 - (vi) Spitting shall be strictly prohibited.
 - (vii) Installation & use of Aarogya Setu App shall be advised wherever feasible.
15. The students have to provide an undertaking in the prescribed form countersigned by their parents, agreeing to the above rules.
