**Dear Principals,**

All Central, State, Private IHMs and FCIs

**Subject: Advisory to IHMs and FCIs Regarding Revision in the Conduct of End Semester Examinations 2024-25.**

In light of the ongoing border tensions, all Institutes of Hotel Management (IHMs) and Food Craft Institutes (FCIs) are hereby advised to remain vigilant and take precautionary measures in accordance with State and Local Government directives.

1. Adherence to State/Local Advisories: All IHMs & FCIs must strictly follow any advisory issued by the respective State Governments, District Administrations, or Education Departments concerning the closure of educational institutions due to security concerns. You are instructed to immediately inform the Council of any such closure orders or directions issued by the authorities in your State or District.

2. **Revised Conduct of Examinations:** Keeping in view the temporary closure of schools and colleges in many states, the Council has revised the date-sheet for the conduct of planned examinations of B.Sc. in Hospitality and Hotel Administration, Trade Diplomas, and Craftsmanship Courses scheduled on 13.05.2025, Tuesday and 14.05.2025, Wednesday.

**These examinations have now been rescheduled to 17.05.2025, Saturday (to be conducted in two shifts).**

This decision has been taken on the basis of the following key considerations:

- Expected normalization of conditions in the affected States/Districts by the rescheduled date, allowing safe and smooth conduct of examinations.
- Timely completion of the examination schedule, enabling students to adhere to their pre-planned travel and return to their home stations without undue delay or inconvenience.

These changes will remain in effect till further orders.

The revised date sheet is attached for your reference. You are requested to communicate the same to all concerned students and teaching faculty members at the earliest.

3. General Precautions and Communication

- Ensure the safety and well-being of students, staff, and teaching faculty members by following all necessary protocols.
- Use official communication channels (email, notice boards, institute websites) to keep stakeholders informed and avoid any misinformation.

All IHMs and FCIs are requested to stay alert and respond swiftly to any developments. The Council will continue to monitor the situation and issue further instructions as required.
